Moving Tips for Chesterton

****Schedule utility connections early:**** Contact NIPSCO for gas and electric service, and set up water/sewer through the Town of Chesterton well before your move date. Cross-state moves mean establishing entirely new utility accounts rather than transfers.

****Plan for toll costs:**** Whether hiring movers or relocating yourself, budget for Chicago Skyway (\$6) and Indiana Toll Road (\$4-8) charges. E-ZPass or I-PASS transponders work on both routes and save time at toll plazas.

****Time your departure from Chicago:**** Leave the city by 9 AM or wait until after 10 AM to avoid morning rush hour. Afternoon moves should depart Chicago after 6:30 PM to avoid evening congestion on outbound routes.

****Update your address with both states:**** File address changes with both Illinois and Indiana for driver's licenses, vehicle registration, and voter registration. Indiana requires establishing residency for various services and documentation.

****Consider storage timing:**** If your Chesterton home isn't ready immediately, Northwest Indiana storage facilities are significantly more affordable than Chicago options. This flexibility can ease timing pressures during cross-state transitions.

****Verify homeowners insurance coverage:**** Switching states requires new homeowners or renters insurance policies. Shop rates before moving, as Indiana premiums are typically lower than Illinois, providing additional savings.
