

Moving Guide: Elk Grove Village, IL

The logistics of moving in Elk Grove Village differ significantly from urban Chicago relocations, primarily due to the suburban housing stock and street layout. However, multi-level homes with basements and staircases require careful planning for large furniture items and appliances. The village's well-maintained streets and clear traffic patterns generally allow for

efficient moving truck access, though you should consider rush hour timing if your move day coincides with weekday commuting hours. Major highways including I-290, Route 83, and the Elgin-O'Hare Expressway serve the area, so coordinate your moving schedule to avoid peak traffic times typically between 7-9 AM and 4-6 PM. Most residential areas don't require special parking permits for moving trucks, but always verify specific requirements for townhome communities or condominium associations that may have their own rules about loading zones and elevator reservations.

Living Here

Moving Tips for Elk Grove Village

1. ****Check HOA and condo association rules early****: If moving into a townhome or condominium community, contact the association at least two weeks before your move to understand their specific requirements for elevator reservations, loading dock access, and designated moving hours.
1. ****Plan for basement and multi-level navigation****: Most Elk Grove Village homes feature basements and multiple stories. Measure doorways, stairwell dimensions, and hallway widths beforehand to ensure large furniture and appliances can navigate tight spaces.
1. ****Schedule around O'Hare flight paths and business park traffic****: If moving on a

weekday, avoid morning (7-9 AM) and evening (4-6 PM) rush hours when commuters travel to and from the business park and airport, which can create significant traffic congestion on main roads.

1. ****Protect hardwood floors and carpeting****: Many suburban homes feature finished hardwood floors and quality carpeting throughout. Use floor runners and protective coverings to prevent damage during the move, especially during wet or snowy months.
1. ****Arrange utilities in advance****: Contact ComEd for electricity, Nicor Gas for natural gas, and the village for water service at least one week before your move date to ensure everything is active when you arrive.
1. ****Consider garage and driveway advantages****: Unlike city moves requiring street parking coordination, most Elk Grove Village properties offer driveway access directly to garages, allowing for more efficient loading and unloading with protection from weather.

Getting Settled

Once you've completed your move to Elk Grove Village, start by registering your vehicle with the Village Clerk's office to obtain the required village sticker, typically due by June 30th each year.
