Near North Side requires temporary moving truck parking permits for most residential streets, which must be requested at least 10 business days in advance through the City of Chicago 311 system. Since parking enforcement is extremely active in Zone 4, proper permits aren't just recommended—they're essential for avoiding fines and delays on moving day. High-rise buildings may require elevator reservations weeks in advance, and many luxury buildings have specific moving hours, typically weekdays before 4 PM. Factor in potential street festivals, marathons, or special events along Michigan Avenue that could affect access to your building.

Living Here
